School Policies

Dear Parents/Carers,

Earlier this week, I shared our new Allergy Policy with you following its approval by the Governing Body. As part of the same programme of policy reviews, a number of other school policies have also recently been updated and approved. Copies of these policies are attached and available on our website.

The key updates are:

- Online Safety Policy - updated to reflect current guidance and developments in online safety, including the use of artificial intelligence (AI), filtering and monitoring arrangements, and our ongoing work to help children use technology safely and responsibly.
- Appropriate Use of Mobile Phones Policy - updated in line with recent government legislation and guidance, reinforcing the expectation that schools are mobile phone-free environments for pupils during the school day, except in very limited exceptional circumstances.
- Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE) Policy - updated following the consultation with parents, staff, pupils and governors last year and reflects both statutory requirements and feedback received during that process.
- Safeguarding Policy - updated to reflect the latest requirements set out in Keeping Children Safe in Education 2026 and to ensure our safeguarding procedures continue to meet national expectations and best practice.
